Production and use of nitrogen fertilizers in agriculture accounts for around 5% of global greenhouse gas emissions. Recent studies have found that emissions stemming from the use of fertilizers could be reduced to approximately one-fifth of current levels by 2050 if a variety of interventions are applied.
